Teen and Parent Driving Agreement

Before You Drive:

- 1. Check in with one of us (hereafter referred to as "us") before you drive. You must have consent to use the car each and every time;
- 2. Let us know where you are going and what time to expect you home.

Safe Habits; in the Car; and Driving:

- 1. Always wear a seat belt, and make sure all of your passengers wear seat belts;
- 2. Obey all traffic laws and posted signs;
- 3. Never speed, tailgate, weave in and out of traffic or participate in any aggressive or reckless driving behavior;
- 4. Never engage in thrill-seeking, stunts, or any form of racing;
- 5. Consider the weather and road conditions and adjust your speed appropriately;
- 6. Never allow anyone else to drive our vehicle.

Consequences for violations: No driving for _	weeks/months.

Passengers:

- 1. Abide by the passenger requirements for "L", which are as follows:
 - Supervisor must be age 25+, with a valid Class 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 licence, and must sit beside you in the front passenger seat;
 - Limit of 1 passenger in addition to the supervisor.





- 2. Abide by the passenger requirements for "N", which are as follows:
 - 1 passenger only (immediate family exempt) unless with supervisor age 25+, with a valid Class 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 licence.

Consequences for violations: No driving for ______ weeks/months.

Distractions: Cell Phones, Food and Music:

- 1. Never participate in any behavior that makes you look away from the road or distracts you from driving;
- 2. Set rules for your passengers, so that they do not distract you, and if they are distracting you, pull over to a safe location until the distractions are stopped before driving again;
- 3. Never use your cell phone while the car is moving. This includes talking and texting. Pull over to call, text or use the vehicle GPS;
- 4. Do not use earphones in the car;
- 5. Do not eat or drink while you are driving;
- 6. Do not smoke in the car or allow others to smoke in the car.

Consequences for violations: No driving for ______ weeks/months.

Drugs and Alcohol:

- 1. Absolutely zero tolerance for use of drugs or alcohol;
- 2. Never drive if you have used any drugs or alcohol;
- 3. Never allow drugs or alcohol into your car by any passenger;
- 4. Never allow passengers who have used drugs or alcohol into your car.

Consequences for violations: No driving for a minimum of 6 months; more at our discretion.

In Other Cars:

- 1. Never get into another car with a driver who has used drugs or alcohol;
- 2. Never get into another car where drugs or alcohol are present;
- 3. Always wear a seatbelt while a passenger in someone else's car.



- 4. If you cannot reach us for any reason, and you are concerned for your safety as a driver or passenger, take a cab home and we will pay for it.




Be a Good Friend:

- 3. If the unsafe behavior continues, ask to be let out, and call us or a cab.


